This is an **entry-level, physical, outdoor job**. No experience required—we will train you.

This position runs from **March through the end of the growing season (November)**.

Pay & Schedule

- \$18.00 per hour
- 32–40 hours per week
- 9am-5:30pm, Monday–Friday schedule (occasional long days during peak season)

- Sort and pack fresh produce
- Load and unload trucks
- Clean packing areas and equipment
- Maintaining, organizing, and restocking facilities inventories
- Maintaining daily Food Safety practices
- Help with deliveries as needed
- Assist with general farm and food hub tasks

- Lifting up to 50 lbs regularly
- Working outdoors or in open Pack Area in hot, cold, dusty, or rainy weather
